

This list is for guidance only and is not necessarily a complete list.

PLEASE PACK ENOUGH CLOTHING FOR EACH DAY PLUS SPARE SET IN CASE OF SOAKING.

A reasonable guide is one set of clothes for each day PLUS one more to cover getting wet or dirty.

All items must be marked clearly with your son/daughter's name.

Medication

Any medicines required, labeled with your son's name and details of dosage etc. and in a clear sealable bag, (*Parents must hand to a leader at the start of camp*).

!!Your scout is responsible for his own kit while at camp!!

It will help if your scout helps to pack his own kit,

It is a requirement of the 'Campers' badge.

Please make a point of emphasizing where their torch, sleeping clothes and wash kit are located.

Please bring a sense of humour and leave all tantrums neatly folded up in a drawer at home!



Rucksack with liner or black bag

(No suitcases please they're camping not being evacuated)

CLOTHING

Fleece and/or Jumper

Hat *(One for sun and a woolly one to sleep in)*

Shirts long sleeve

Shorts

Socks *(Thick ones for boots or wear 2 pairs thin ones at once)*

Swimming shorts

T-Shirts *(These may grow legs and find their own way home after)*

Trainers 1 pair *(Not your best new pair they may get ruined)*

Trousers *(Warm but not jeans)*

Undies

UNIFORM *(Shirt, scarf, trousers, belt, woggle etc + a Coat hanger and plastic bag to keep it in when not being worn)*

Walking Boots *(Strong waterproof/hiking type)*

Waterproof Top/Jacket *(Thin so can be worn with layers underneath)*

Waterproof trousers *(Thin so can be worn with layers underneath)*

Wellingtons *(Very useful when it's really wet)*

SLEEPING & WASHING

Foam mattress pad *(no inflatables please they're too big)*

Pillow *(Small can be inflatable or they can use their rucksacks)*

Pyjamas or track suit *(Optional – most sleep in t-shirt & shorts)*

Extra Blanket *(Nights under canvas are cold even in Summer)*

Sleeping Bag *(Mummy ones with hoods are good)*

Towel *(Medium size)*

Wash kit *(Soap, Flannel, Toothbrush & paste – usually returned unused)*

PLEASE NOTE

All items must be marked clearly with your son/daughter's name.

NO JEANS *(They take ages to dry out)*



OTHER ESSENTIALS

Knife, fork, spoon

Pen, pencil & paper

Spare Batteries

Sun cream (*SPF 30+*)

Tea towels x2 (*Old you may not want them back after they've used them*)

Torch with new batteries

(Wrongly fit batteries to prevent accidental use when packed)

Tissues (*Small travel packs are best*)

Toilet roll (*In case there's a shortage*)

Unbreakable Large plate, bowl and mug

Water bottle

Water free hand cleanser

Black Bag for dirty clothes

(Be prepared to receive a large pile of items both worn and unused mashed into on large, muddy, smelly and mildly infectious bundle)

PLEASE NOTE

All items must be marked clearly with your son/daughter's name.

NO ELECTRONIC ITEMS: Radios, mobile phones, iPods etc

NO EXTRA FOOD PARCELS

NO KNIVES

Any of the above will be confiscated if brought along and 1st Shepperton Scout Group will not be responsible for their safety and well being.
